Committee on Road Safety

5381. SHRI CHHITTUBHAI GAMIT: Will the Minister of SHIPPING AND TRANSPORT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any Committee had been appointed by his Ministry on road safety;
- (b) if so, the details regarding its report alongwith the main recommendations made by the Committee; and
- (c) what is the average death rate per year for every ten thousand vehicles in different Matropolitan cities and the measures that have been suggested to reduce the mortality rate?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SHIPPING AND TRANSPORT (SHRIZ. R. ANSARI): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. The Road Safety Committee had examined in detail various aspects of road safety and emphasized the need for all-out nationwide efforts. The measures recommended by the Committee are the setting up of a chain of motor driving training schools, a

central school for training the instructors for such schools, tightening the enforcement of regulations regards ing issuance of driving licences and certificates of physical fitness for vehicles, formulation of uniform traffic code, Scheme of Highway Patrolling with traffic aid posts, study/introduction of suitable changes in vehicle design from road safety angle, system of executive magistrates for trying traffic offences, survey of accidentprone spots, scheme for providing wayside amenities, creation of traffic engineering divisions as well as Education and publicity measures through various media to bring in full awareness of road safety.

The Committee had also recommended the creation of Road-safety directorates in the States with suitable co-ordinating machinery at the Centre for formulation, implementation and minotoring of road safety programmes as also creation of a road safety fund and road safety councils.

Some of the important measures that have been taken by amending M. V. Act, in 1982 to curb the tendencies of violation of traffic laws with a view to prevent occurrence of road accidents causing loss of precious lives are enhancement of amount of penalties/fine in respect of traffic offences like allowing unauthorised person to drive a vehicle, driving at excessive speed, driving recklessly and dangeriously, racing and trials of speed; making it compulsory to carry driving licence with a photograph affixed thereon.

State Governments, who have executive responsibility for implementation of provision of M. V. Act, and rules made thereunder, have been requested to tighten the enforcement of traffic rules and regulations including issuance of driving licence and certificate of fitness of vehicles.

The Traffic Aid Posts, which are set up under National Highway Patrolling Scheme on selected sectors of National Highways, inter-alia, are required to provide immediate first aid medical assistance and to carry victims of accidents to the nearest medical center.
