9297. SHRIMATI GEETA MUKHER-JEE: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleasad to state:

- (a) whether Indian Council of Agricultural Research supports many Krishi Vigyan Kendras; if so, Kendra-wise location and date of start:
- (b) the allocation made during Sixth Plan, Kendra-wise vis-a-vis amount actually utilized during 1980-81 to 1983-84 and the allocation proposed for 1914-85; and
- (c) whether Government propose to constitute a high powered committee to examine operation of this scheme; if so, when and if not, the reasons thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI YOGENDRA MAKWANA) : (a) Yes, Sir. The Indian Council of agricultural Research provides grants for establishment of Krishi Vigyan Kendras in the country. The Kendrawise location and date of start may be seen in statement-I [Placed in library see No. LT-8313/84].

- (b) The Sixth Plan allocation made Kendra-wise vis-a-vis amount utilised during 1980-81 to 1983-84 and the allocation proposed for 1984-85 may be seen in statement-II Placed in library see No. LT-8313/84]
- (c) The Indian Council of Agricultural Research had constituted in the year 1980 a High Level Evaluation Committee to examine the operation of the scheme of Krishi Vigyan Kendras. The Committee has already submitted its report in the November 1980 and hence there is no need to constitute a high-power committee to examine the operation of this scheme.

Doors leading to balconies have double shutters for sequrity reason. Inner shutter is partly panelled and partly of steel jali; second shutter is glazed. There is no security risk.
