THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI YOGENDRA MAKWANA): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The amount of financial assistance provided by the NCDC to Co-operative Sugar Factories and Co-operative Spinning Mills during the 6th Five Year Plan, yearwise, is as follows:

Requirement of foodgrains

- 9381. SHRI SUDHIR KUMAR GIRI: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:
- (a) whether it is a fact that the total production of foodgrains would reach the peak level of 146 million tonnes this year;
- (b) if so, the factors for such high production in our country;
- (c) the total quantity of foodgrains to be at Government's disposal for distribution; and
- (d) whether Goveanment have assessed the total necessity of foodgrains this year in the country?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI YOGENDRA MAKWANA): (a) and (b) According to the latest assessment, total foodgrains productions during 1983-84 is estimated to be around 149.8 million tonnes. This high production has been due, interalia, to increased supply of fertilizers and seed minikits, appropriate extension measures, extension of area under irrigation/high yielding varieties, adoption of remunerative price policy, use of improved agricultural implements, special production campaigns, particularly for rice etc. and generally favourable weathes conditions.

- (c) As on 1.4.1984, the stock position of foodgrains with the Central and State Governments has been assessed at about 149.5 lakhs tonnes. This is likely to be augmented considerably with the procurement of wheat in the current season.
- (d) Government have carried out a general assessment of requirements of foodgrains for distribution through the Public Distribution System and other schemes.
