THE MINISTER OF FINANCE (SHRI PRANAB MUKHERJEE) : (a) Statement-I attached gives latest position of overdraft of each State.

(b) Statement-II attached shows the Central assistance allocated for State Plan Schemes, State-wise for 1984-85.

(c) Against the originally allocated Central assistance of Rs 680.26 crores for the five year period 1980-85 for West Bengal, a sum of Rs. 728.06 crores has been released during the first four years of the Plan. State's entitlement of Central assistance as per accepted criteria amounting to Rs 33.76 crores for the year 1984-85 is not being released as the plan outlay of the State has not been finalised.
