Use of Bagasse as Raw Material for Paper Plants

- 4373. SHRI BALASAHEB VIKHE PATIL: Will the Minister of INDUSTRY be pleased to state:
- (a) whether the amount of bagasse produced in sugar manufacturing units can offer a good opportunity to set up paper plants with bagasse as raw material in the country;
- (b) if so, whether Government would offer loan through financial institutions to set up such units; and
- (c) if so, whether any directions has already been given to the financial institutions; if not, when Government propose to issue the same?

THE MINISTER OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY AND OF THE DEPART-MENT OF SUPPLY (SHRI VISHWA-NATH PRATAP SINGH): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) and (c). The financial institutions consider applications for institutional assistance on merits, and some schemes have already been anctioned.

Proposal to Convert P.H.Cs at Block Headquarters into Community Health Centres

- 4374. PROF. NARAIN CHAND PARASHAR: Will the Minister HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:
- (a) whether Government have any plan to convert the Primary Health Centres at Block Headquarters into Community Health Centres to provide better medical facilities in rural areas; and
- (b) if so, the number of Block Headquarters already having Community Health Centres as on date and the likely date by which all Block Headquarters would be covered by Community Health Centres?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (KUMARI KUMUDBEN M. JOSHI): (a) One Community Centre is to be established to cover 4 Primary Health Centres. This Community Health Centre can be established either by upgrading one of the Primary Health Centres or by upgrading one of the hospital at Taluk/Tehsil level, which is easily approachable from the Primary Health Centres to be covered.

(b) According to the information available, 472 Community Health Centres have been established in the country as on 1.4.84. The required number of C.H.Cs would be established in a phased manner by 2000 A.D.
