Import of Technological know-how from M/s. Toyo Jozo, Japan

1376. SHRI CHINTAMANI JENA: Will the Minister of CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS be pleased to state:

- the details of the technologies imported, outflow of foreign exchange and valuewise cash saving made by various companies individually after taking technoligical know-how for the manufacture of drugs and drug intermediates from M/s. Toyo Jozo, Japan:
- (b) the details of current technologies that are under implementation in the country for the manufacture of drugs and drug intermediates;
- (c) whether any assessment of the technologies supplied by M/s. Toyo Jozo has been made;
- (d) if so, the details of technologies involved and result thereof; and
- (e) if not, the steps taken by Government to ensure the economic viability in each individual case?

OF THE MINISTER CHEMI-CALS AND FERTILIZERS VASANT SATHE): (a) to (e) Only two companies have been allowed to import technology from M/s. Toyo Jozo. One is M/s. Hindustan Antibiotics Limited (HAL), a public sector undertaking and the other is M/s. Max India who are in the private sector. HAL have paid R. 41.85 lakhs for import of technology for improved strain and know-how for Penicillin. It is assessed that the fees paid for import of technology have been more than recovered through the improvement in efficiencies and yields.

As regards M/s. Max India, they we're permitted in the first half of 1983 to import technology for 6-APA at a cost of Yen 123 million, I/5th of which has since been remitted to M/s. Toyo Jozo. Since the implementation of the project is going on, no assessment of technology is possible at this stage.
