Indian Doctors serving in U.S.A.

(a) whether it is a fact that a large number of Indian Doctors are serving in U.S.A. in Medical Proficiency;

(b) if so, the number of such doctors; and \cdot

(c) the number of students passed every year in India in Medical line and how many of them are going abroad every year ? THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY PLANNING (SHRI D. P. CHATTOPA-DHYAYA): (a) Some Indian doctors migrate U.S.A. for better prospects. Many go abroad for higher education and training and are expected to come back.

(b) According to information recently ascertained from the American Medical Association, Chicago. 3,900 Indian doctors are reported to be practising or employed in the United States of America.

(c) The number of medical students who graduated during 1969 was 9,315. The information regarding number of medical graduates going abroad is not known. However, on the basis of the number of passports issued, 2215 medical doctors had gone abroad during 1967.

Setting up of Factories for Manufacturing Insecticides in U, P.
