(b) Within the available resources every effort is being made to provide as many residential units in the general pool at various places as possible. During the Fourth Five Year Plan it is proposed to construct, 4,495 residential units in different types in Maharashtra, Mysore, Tamil Nadu and West Bengal.

Kerala state is covered by the Air Force Recruiting Office at Bangalore. Apart from conducting recruitment of Airmen at Bangalore, the Air Force Recruiting Officer, Bangalore, also undertakes tours in his zone including places in Kerala state and carries out recruitment locally at various places. The tour programmes are given wide publicity. The present system is working satisfactorily.
