

**THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF IRRIGATION AND POWER (SHRI B. N. KUREEL)** : (a) There is a provision of Rs. 6 crores for new generation schemes in the Fourth Plan outlay of Mysore State. Funds will be provided for Kalinadi Project from out of this amount during the Fourth Plan.

(b) The load demand of Goa at present is 21 MW, out of which 19 MW are met from Power supply from the Mysore Grid. The load demand in Goa is expected to rise to 80 MW by 1973-74. 50 MW would be available from Mysore on completion of 9th & 10th generating units at Sharavathi.

As regards supply from Kalinadi Project, Mysore Government has recently indicated that additional power to Goa after 1973-74 could be reviewed only after the first stage of Kalinadi H. E. Project is completed. At present there is no definite mention by them of any allocation of power to Goa from the Kalinadi Project.

(c) If the Goa Government makes such a request to the Central Government, it will be considered.

**Overbridge on Railway track on new Rohtak Road, New Delhi**

4061. **SHRI DALIP SINGH** : Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state :

(a) the progress made so far towards constructing an overbridge on the Railway track on new Rohtak Road near Sarai Rohialla, New Delhi ;

(b) the reasons for delay, if any; and

(c) the time likely to be taken to its completion ?

**THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI HANUMANTHAIYA)** : (a) The contract for the railway's portion of the work was awarded in March, 1971, and the work has also since been commenced.

(b) There were a number of Jhuggies at the site of this road overbridge. These have been recently got removed with the help of the Civil authorities.

(c) The Railway's portion of the work on the bridge structure is likely to be completed by June, 1972. The work on the approaches to the bridge is to be done by the Municipal Corporation of Delhi.

**Over/under Bridge near Harkesh Nagar, Mathura Road, Delhi**

4092. **SHRI DALIP SINGH** : Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state :

(a) whether a number of accidents have occurred on the railway track near Harkesh Nagar, a village situated opposite Okhla Sewerage tank on Mathura Road, Delhi ;

(b) whether any representation has been made to the Railway for providing a small over/under Bridge for the use of the residents of that village, who have to cross the Railway track frequently for attending to their work ; and

(c) the action taken or proposed to be taken in the matter ?

**THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI HANUMANTHAIYA)** : (a) No accident has occurred on track near the village Harkesh Nagar during the last three years.

(b) and (c). There were representations from the villagers for provision of a level crossing opposite the Okhla tank. Being a new facility, the party was asked to approach the State Government for sponsoring the proposal, together with an undertaking to bear the full costs, initial as well as recurring. No such proposal has been received from the State Government.

**Sub-letting of Vending Licences**

4093. **SHRI CHANDRIKA PRASAD** : Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state :

(a) whether most of the vending licences are sub-let by the owners over the Western Railway ;

(b) if so, the action taken by Government to check such mal-practice ; and

(c) whether in future Government propose to adopt auction system of the stalls instead of the present policy of licensing ?
