few selected potential ore bearing areas of Andhra Pradesh, Rajasthan and Bihar-West Bengal As a result of this survey, which was completed on schedule, a large number of geophysical anomalics have been revealed The ground follow-up in selected anomaly sites has revealed promising zinc, lead mineralisation in Rajasthan area and copper mineralisation in Bihar area Minor occurrences of molybdonum have also been recorded in Raiasthan area Further drilling is in progress to evaluate the extent and grade of the ore bodies. The results achieved under project 'Operation Hardlock' so far are encouraging

French aided project for aerial survey has been taken up not because of the failure of 'Operation Hardrock' but with a view to speed up exploration for nonferrous metals for which aerial survey over additional areas in selected parts of Mysore Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra and Rajasthan was considered necessary and for which indigenous expertise was not available

(c) The ground follow-up work on the aero-anomalies located by the Operation Hardrock' Project is still in progress The question of exploitation (t minerals which may be located as a result of these operations will be considered after completion of the ground follow-up work
