SAKSENA : Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state the position in regard to the construction of a Branch Post Office in village Gujranilla Shankar Misra, presently served by is Naikot Post Office in Gorakhpur District, about which an application was given to the Superintendent, Post Offices, Gorakhpur and the Post-Master General, Uttar Pradesh in November, 1970 ?

THE MINISTER OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI H. N. BAHUGUNA) : The applications for opening a post office in village Gujranilla Shankar Misra stated to

have been given to Superintendent of Post Offices, Gorakhpur and Postmaster-General, Uttar Pradesh in November, 1970 does not appear to have been received by them. The proposal has now been taken up for examination by Postmaster-General, Lucknow. The opening of a Post Office in village Gujranilla Shankar Misra will depend upon fulfilment of departmental standards.
