THE MINISTER OF FINANCE(VITTA MANIRI) (SHRI YESHWANT RAO (HAVAN): (a) and (b). A development loan agreement for Cs 40 million (about Rs. 28 crores) was signed with the Canadian Government on April 7, 1971. The loan is intended for financing the import of certain industrial commodities and fertilizers from Canada. It is repayable over a period of 50 years inclusive of a 10 year grace period with no interest or any other service thargs.
