The Unemployed Commercial Pilots Association submitted a memorandum which made certain suggestions for creating job opportunities for unemployed commercial pilots. The suggestions include, *inter-alia*, their absorption in the Civil Aviation Depart-

ment and employment in aerial operations connected with crop spraying,

(c) The Government has taken the following action :—

(i) The recruitment rules for direct recruitment to the post of Assistant Aerodrome Officer have been amended to include a Commercial Pilots' Licence as one of the acceptable qualifications and a requisition for recruitment against 78 posts of Assistant Aerodrome Officers has been sent to the Union Public Service Commission ; and

(ii) The Ministry of Agriculture have been requested to consider the question of encouraging crop spraying operators to recruit unemployed pilots give them some training and utilise them on light aircraft.
