- (b) The main reasons for the loss ere .-
 - Labour unrest causing frequent disruption of services;
 - 2. Increase in wages.
 - Increase in excise duty on aviation fuel:
 - Loss of three F-27 aircraft;
 - 5. Rerouting of certain services to avoid overflying Pakistan;

- 6. Suspension of some service due to 5 above, and
- 7. Increase in insurance for hijacking risks.
- (c) Indian Airlines have submitted certain proposals in this regard which are under consideration.

Arrest of Income Tax Officer of Agra

(b) The Income-Tax Officer, Shri B. R. Sant, was caught in the act of accepting a sum of Rs 2 lakhs as illegal gratification from the Manager of a foreign Bank in consideration of the release of some property belonging to an engineering firm of agra which had been hypothecated to the Bank but was later attached by the said Income Tax Officer.

Three other persons were also arrested and taken in to police custody in connection with the same matter.

Further investigation is in progress.
