

Licensing of Nursing Homes and clinics

90. SHRI H. K. L. BHAGAT :
SHRI C. CHITTIBABU :

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY PLANNING be pleased to state :

(a) whether Government are considering proposals for licensing all Nursing Homes and Clinics in all States and Union Territories ;

(b) if so, the broad particulars thereof ; and

(c) when they are likely to be given effect to and what would be the advantages for the same ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY PLANNING (PROF. D. P. CHATTO-PADHYAYA) (a) to (c) Yes. Government have under consideration the following resolution passed in October, 1971 by the Central Council of Health.

"All the State Governments may take steps to frame Registration Act with a view to bring all the nursing homes under the Act so that only registered medical practitioners and nurses are employed in these nursing homes."

Admission for M. B. B. S. Course in Delhi

(a) the number of students who passed the Pre-Medical Examination in Delhi this year in first division and had applied for admission for MBBS course ;

(b) how many of them were given admission ; and

(c) what is proposed to be done to those who are left out ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY PLANNING (PROF. D. P. CHATTO-PADHYAYA) : (a) 465 students passed Pre-Medical Examination of Delhi University in first division this year (1971). It is not

known how many of them applied for admission to the MBBS Course.

(b) and (c). The number of Delhi Pre-Medical first division students who have secured admission in the various medical colleges in Delhi/Meerut is as follows :—

1. Maulana Azad Medical College, New Delhi	175
2. Lady Hardinge Medical College, New Delhi	99
3. All-India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi	14
4. New Medical College, Delhi and Medical College, Meerut.	172
TOTAL 460	

The remaining students are expected to have secured admission in colleges outside Delhi.
