U.S.S.R.-Egypt Communique

749. SHRI BIRENDER SINGH RAO : Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state :

(a) whether joint communique of USSR-Egypt issued by those countries in October, 1971 after Indo-USSR treaty, was contrary to India stand on Bangla Desh ; and

(b) if so, the reaction of Government of India thereto ?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SARI SURENDRA PAL SINGH) : (a) The joint communique issued at the end of President Sadat's visit to Moscow in October, 1971 makes no mention of Bangla Desh or India.

Foreign Help for Refugees

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND REHABILITATION be pleased to state :

(a) the names of the countries which had extended their help financially and otherwise for the refugees from Bangla Desh ;

(b) the extent of help promised by each country ;

(c) how far these countries have fulfilled their offer or promise ; and

(d) the reaction of Government in cases where the help offered was more but the help actually provided was negligible ?

THE MINISTER OF LABOUR AND REHABILITATION (SHRI R. K. KHADILKAR) : (a) and (b). A statement showing the offers of assistance received from foreign Governments, UN Agencies and Voluntary organisations, as per information received by the Department of Rehabilitation upto 15-11-1971, is laid on the Table of the House. [Placed in Library. See No. LT—1033/71].

(c) Government has received aid in cash amounting to Rs. 10.78 crores from the foreign countries. Besides the aid in cash, the Government have also received aid in kind from the foreign countries in the form of food stuffs (rice, edible oil, sugar), shelter material, vehicles, medical supplies etc. The value of foreign assistance actually received by us including the cash so far is about Rs. 50 to 55 crores. The rest is currently on the high seas and is expected to arrive in the next few months.

(d) Government are helpful of receiving promised aid from various countries/agencies shortly.

Views of Foreign Countries on Indo-Soviet Treaty

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI SURENDRA PAL SINGH) : (a) and (b). Government are not aware of any country having assailed the Indo-Soviet Treaty of Peace, Friendship and Cooperation.
