F. H. MOHSIN). (a) The Bureau of Police

Research and Development set up in the Ministry of Home Affairs is engaged in a number of research projects dealing with the police and its problems and on the developmental side is concerned with evolution of new techniques in the administration, management, maintenance of law and order etc, in the police. The Bureau is in constant touch with the State Governments and their Inspectors General of Police so that the results of studies conducted by the Bureau are available to the State police forces as quickly as possible. Towards this end the projects have been divided into those which have immediate application and those which are of a long-term nature. Priority has been given for the former category of projects.

(b) All the States have access to the results of research and development work done by the Bureau. To facilitate the police forces in the country being modernised and the suggestions of the various project studies made by the Bureau duly implemented, a loan-cum grant assistance is also being given to the State Governments so that the police forces become and remain modern, efficient and capable of handling their responsibilities effectively.
