As the current season is still on, and some sugar factories are still working, the cost of production cannot be worked out precisely at this stage

Enquiry into sinking of Sweedish Gift Vessel attached to Madras Unit of Central Institute of Fisheries Operatives

7687, SHRI VAYALAR RAVI: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) whether the new Sweedish gift vessel "Red snapper" attached to the Madras Unit of the Central Institute of Fisheries Operatives got almost sunk at the harbour by getting sea water in the Engine Room;

(b) whether any enquiry has been conducted to fix responsibility in this regard; and

(c) if so, the results thereof ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI ANNASAHEB P. SHINDE) : (a) While the vessel "Red Snapper" was undergoing annual overhaul at the Madras harbour, it was noticed on the morning of Monday. the 5th July 1971, that sea water had entered the engine and forward compartment. The water was baled out by 10 A. M. and the main engine was restarted the next day.
