## Economic Aid to Mauritius

1519. SHRI B S. BHAURA : Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state :

(a) whether Government have offered economic aid to Maurituus; and

(b) if so, the nature thereto?

THE MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI SWARAN SINGH) : (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The Government have offered economic aid to the Government of Mauritius in the shape of technical experis and equipment for several projects identified as suitable for such aid. Part of the aid will be given as an outright grant up to a limit of Rs. 101 lakhs and the rest of it has been offered as a loan up to an amount of Rs. 321 lakhs. All this aid will be applied to important sectors in the development plan of Mauritius. The following items will be covered under grant:

- (i) Mahatma Gandhi Institute,
- (ii) Advisory services for Western Coastal Region Irrigation Project.
- (111) Experts and Equipment for Industrial Technical Training Institute.
- (iv) Subsidy for Maize supply for Livestock Feed Factory.
- (v) Consultancy for Central Electricity Board.
- (vi) Industrial Estate :
  - (a) Project and Feasibility Report.
  - (b) Machinery for common workshop and facilities centre.
- (vii) Technical experts.

The loan will cover the following projects -

- (i) Western Coastal Region Irrigation Project
  - (a) Consultancy by WAPCOS for detailed designs, etc.
  - (b) Supply of derocking equipment.
- (ii) Maize for Livestock Feed Factory: 5,000 tonnes.
- (iii) Equipment for Telephone and Telex services.
- (iv) Central Electricity Board-Machinery and equipment.
