204. SHRIRAMJIRAM: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of posts of I. O. W. Tnnnels Inspectors, Grade-wise and Zone-wise on Indian Railways;
- (b) the category of staff in whose channel of promotion these posts fall and how these have actually been filled; and
- (c) whether there are specialized posts and are filled by promotion of staff who can adequately man these posts, irrespective of their seniority position?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI T. A. PAI): (a) to (c). Information is being collected and will be laid on the Table of the Sabha.

Consortium for Tea Industry

205. SHRI CHANDRA SHRKHAR SINGH: Will the Minister of FOREIGN TRADE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Consortium for Tea Industry to look after its long and short term credit needs, as proposed by the Reserve Bank's Study Group headed by Shri B.K. Dutt, has since been formed;
- (b) if so, the name of its members and the exact nature of functions assigned to it; and
- (c) if not, the reasons for delay and the time by which it will be formed?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN TRADE (SHRI A. C. GEORGE): (a) to (c). The recommendations of the Study Group on Longterm credit needs of the industry are presently under the consideration of the Reserve Bank. in consultation with the term-lending institutions, and it would take some more time for implementing them.
