Mithia Laboratories Madhubani, District Dubhanga Bihai, had approached the (GHS Medical Store Depot (Ayurvedic), 4/19 Asai Ali Road, New Delhi for the supply of Ayurvedic medicines, but the firm was not approved on the following grounds -

- (a) Lack of certificate regarding two years manufacturing of Ayurvedic medicines.
- (b) Lack of certificate as supplier to the Government for the last two years.
- (c) Lack of "no complaint certificate" from the Director of Avurveda of the Bihar State

The firm had further imposed following conditions for making the supplies to the Government which were not acceptable.
