- (a) whether the desirability of reviewing the working of Employment Exchanges with a view to streamlining the procedure followed has been considered; and

THE MINISTER OF LABOUR AND REHABILITATION (SHRI R. K. KHA-DILKAR): (a) and (b). Yes, Sir. With a view to providing efficient and quick service, the procedure is regularly reviewed by the Working Group on National Employment Service on which all State Governments are represented. The decisions taken by the Working Group are communicated to the State Governments, who exercise financial as well as administrative control over the Employment Exchanges and they are advised to implement these decisions.
