3322. SHRI KRISHNA CHANDRA HALDER: Will the Minister of INDUS-TRIAL DEVELOPMENT AND SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the loss in Bharat Opthalmic Glass Project Limited is on the increas;
 - (b) the main reasons for the losses and;
- (c) how Government propose to stop the recurring loss?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRIAL DEVE-LOPMENT (SHRI PRANAB MUKHER-JEE): (a) No. Sir. The estimate loss for the current financial year is Rs. 85.00 lakhs against Rs. 92.87 lakhs for the year 1971-72.
