The areas in which both sides would cooperate include petroleum technology, chemical technology, metaliurgy machine building, refractories, agriculture forestry, leather industry and health engineering. The two sides will also exchange scientific literature of use and interest to each other. There will also be exchange of scientists between the two countries in the specific fields in which they will cooperate.
