Cases of failure of vasectomy operations in States

93 SHRI VIKRAM MAHAJAN Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY PLANNING be pleased to state

(a) the number of such vasectomy cases in various States State-wise during the last three years where the persons concerned were capable of producing children even after going in for vasectomy operations

(b) the number of persons during the said period in the country who died of infectious diseases as a result of vasectomy operations and

(c) the reaction of Government thereto and the steps taken to check the recurrence of cases as referred to in (a) and (b) above?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY PLANNING (SHRI A K KIS KUR (a) These figures are not collected. However, the persons even

after vasectomy operations continue to be capable of producing children for a total twelve ejaculations. Some studies in certain local areas also indicate the presence of sperms on semen examination even subsequent to 12 ejaculations after the operations. The percentage of such cases did not exceed 6.14 per cent in any area.

(b) The number of deaths due to infection (tetanus) after vasectomy operations during the last 3 years is as follows

(c) Vasectomised cases are regularly given twelve pieces of Nirodhs and advised to use the same in the post operative period and are also advised to get their semen examination done after 3 months to be sure that the operation has become effective.

Detailed guidelines indicating the precautions to be taken to avoid

failure and post-operative complications have been sent to all the State Governments and Union Territories.
