Cases taken to Law Courts under the M.R.T.P. Act

2787. SHRI F. V VIKHE PATIL: Will the Minister of LAW, JUSTICE AND COMPANY AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of cases under the M.R.T.P. Act which have been taken to law courts since 1970 and the number of such cases which have been finally decided.
- (b) the number of cases which have finally been decided against Government;
- (c) whether Government, in the light of various judgements of the law courts and other experience gained during the administration of the Act, propose to plug the loopholes noticed so far by amending the Act; and
- (d) if so, when the amending Bill is proposed to be introduced in Parliament?

THE DIPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF LAW, JUSTICE AND COMPANY AFFAIRS (SHRI BIDA-BRATA BARUA). (a) and (b). Out of 14 cases taken to the Courts, two cases were withdrawn by the applicant Companies, three have gone in favour of the Government. Out of the 6 cases pending in the Supreme Court, three were filed by the Companies and three by Government. In three cases appeals filed by the Companies against the Commission itself, one was decided in favour and two were dismissed.

(c) and (d) The working of the MR T.P. Act is under constant review of the Government. The question of amending the M.R.T.P. Act with a view to plug the loopholes in the working is engaging the attention of the Government. Judicial pronouncements by the High Court/Supreme Court made in this connection will be kept in view before finalising the amendments to the Act.

Major Irrigation Facilities in Himachal Pradesh during Fourth Plan

2788. SHRI VIRBHADRA SINGH: Will the Minister of IRRIGATION AND POWER be pleased to state how far the target of Fourth Plan for the major irrigation facilities in Himachal Pradesh has been achieved?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF IRRIGATION AND POWER (SHRI SIDDHESHWAR PRASAD): No project in the major/medium irrigation sector was proposed for implementation in Himachal Pradesh during the Fourth Plan.

Pilferage of Goods from Raliway Godowns at Katihar (Bihar)

2789. SHRI JAGANNATH MISHRA Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleas ed to state:

- (a) whether a large scale pilferage of goods from railway godowns is rampant at Katihar (Bihar),
- (b) whether the railway goods yard has become an easy hunting ground for the seal breakers and anti-social elements; and
- (c) if so, the estimated loss as a result thereof during 1972-73 and the steps taken by Covernment in this regard?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MOHD. SHAFI QURESHI): (a) and (b) It is not a fact that thefts and pilferages are rampant at Katihar but the yard being quite large and open at several points, some cases of criminal interference with booked consignments have occurred there.

(c) The estimated loss of goods due to thefts and pilferages at Katihar was Rs. 19,746 during 1972-73.

The following measures have been taken to prevent thefts and pilierages of goods reasons therefor; and at Katihar:---

- (i) Yard and Goods Shed are guard- achieve the target? ed round the clock by the R.P.F.
- (ii) Petrolling by armed R.P.F. men and Dog Squads in vulnerable sectors of the Yard and Goods Shed have been intensified.
- (iii) Assistance and co-operation of nolice and railway unions is sought in apprehension of criminals and receivers of stolen property.

Target of Irrigation Facilities to Himachal Pradesh in 1st Year of Fifth Plan

2790. SHRI VIRBHADRA SINGH . Will the Minister of IRRIGATION AND POWER be pleased to state.

- (a) whether the target of irrigation facilities to be extended to Himachal Pradesh by the Central Government during the 1st year of Fifth Plan has been finalised; and
- (b) if so, the particulars of projects proposed and the capacity of each?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE OF MINISTRY IRRIGATION **VD** POWER (SHRI SIDDHFSHWAR PR 4-SAD): (a) Irrigation is a State subject and the irrigation projects are implemented by the State Governments as part of their developmental plans. The Annual Plan of Himachal Pradesh for 1974-75 has yet to be finalised.

Target of Power Generation in Himachal Pradesh

Against a target of 109.3 MW of generating capacity at the end of the Fourth Plan, it is expected that only 48.3 MW would be commissioned by the end of 1973-74. Due to delay in civil works the commissioning of (2 × 30 MW) 60 MW capacity in the (sire Bata hydel station will not be possible within the Fourth Plan period. Commissioning of one MW (2 × 0.5 MW) at Nogli Hydro Electric Project is also delayed owing to some defects in the plant. The State authorities are expediting works on these projects.

Finalisation of Railway Facilities for Himachal Pradesh during First Year of Fifth Plan
