decided that the bread drought zone should consist of (i) areas faling within the rainfall zone of 750 mm and (ii) areas which have shallow soils falling within isobyetea 750 mm to 800 mm. The second irrigation commission identified the drought zone on the criteria that the probability of critical rainfall shortage should 20 per cent or more and that there should be an adverse water balance. They have, however, excluded talukas or equivalent units where 30 per cent of the cropped area is irrigated.
