## Funds for Setting up Tube Wells in Fourth Plan

Will the Minister of AGRICUL-TURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government had sanctioned money in IV plan period to set up tube wells in the villages for irrigation purpose;

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRIB. P. MAURYA): (a) Yes, Sir. All the States having potentialities for construction of tubewells, had allocated funds in their State Plans during the Fourth Plan period for cetting up tubewells in villages for irrigation purposes.

## Incentives for Irrigation facilities during 1974

- (b) whether any special incentives are being given for providing irrigation by conventional methods wells i.e., tanks in view of the power shortage?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI B. P. MAURYA); (a) The steps taken or proposed to be taken by the Government during 1974 to augment irrigation facilities include:

- (i) Making higher allocations from the Plan Sector funds for irrigation projects as compared to the previous years.
- (ii) Making concerted efforts to mobilise maximum additional financial resources from the institutional like the land development banks, Central cooperative banks, Central banks etc. for minor irrigation schemes.
- (iii) Giving emphasis on completion of irrigation schemes already in hand before taking up new schemes.
- (iv) Giving priority to allocation of power for agricultural purposes.
- (v) Streamlining and making adequate arrangements for timely supply of diesel oil for operation of irrigation pumpsets.
- (vi) Making maximum efforts to expedite and improve the utilisation of irrigation potential already created.
