Major and Medium Schemes during Fifth Plan to Rajasthan

(a) the Major and Medium Irrigation Schemes for providing irrigation facilities during the Fifth Plan period to Rajasthan,

(b) the additional area to be benefited by such schemes, and

(c) the number and particulars of the Irrigation Schemes to be taken up in the backward District?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE AND IRRIGATION SHRI KEDAR NATH SINGH) (a) to (c) The details of the major and medium schemes to be taken up during the Fifth Five Year Plan period in Rajasthan have not yet been finalised. However, the tentative outlay on these schemes for the Fifth Plan is likely to be about Rs. 133.95 crores to create an additional potential of 410 Th. Ha. In selecting new projects, priority is proposed to be given to those which will benefit drought affected, tribal and backward areas.

Criteria for Selecting Candidates for Interview before College Selection Board

Will the Minister of EDUCATION, SOCIAL WELFARE AND CULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) whether calls for interview to the candidates for the post of lecturers in Delhi colleges for Arts subjects are given by the Head of the Department of a particular subject in the University;

(b) whether the Heads of Departments in the University have to adhere to any approved criteria in selecting the candidates for sending for interview before the college Selection Board,

(c) if so, the present rules, if any, framed in this regard and the date when such rules came into effect, and

(d) whether any preference is given to the candidates who have previous experience as lecturer, temporary or part-time in the same subject in the same or some other college in Delhi University itself?

(b) to (d). According to the information furnished by the University, no criteria for selecting candidates to be called for interview has so far been laid down.
