Ban on Formation of Cooperative House Building Societies in Delhi

3701. SHRI ISHWAR CHAUDHRY: Will the Minister of WORKS AND HOUSING be pleased to state:

(a) whether any legal ban or restriction has been imposed on the formation of Cooperative House Building Societies in Delhi after August, 1967 and if so, the relevant legal provisions;

(b) whether the Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Delhi has been discriminating between the members enrolled before August, 1967 and after August, 1967 in the Delhi School Teachers Cooperative House Building Society, Delhi; and

(c) if so, the remedial action proposed?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF WORKS AND HOUSING (SHRI MOHAN DHARIA): (a) No, Sir.

(b) and (c). Due to paucity of land in Delhi administrative instructions were issued to all the Co-operative Societies on the 4th August, 1967 that the list of members submitted by them before that day could be considered as final for allotment of plots and no change in the list could be made without prior written permission of the Delhi Administration.

Neem help save Fertiliser

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND IRRIGATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether Indian Agricultural Research Institute has conducted a research that less fertiliser is needed if urea is applied after being treated in a coaltar solution and blended with neem cake powder.

(b) if so, the facts thereof; and

(c) to what extent it will help to save the fertilizers?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE AND IRRIGATION (SHRI SHAHNAWAZ KHAN) (a) Yes Sir

(b) Research conducted at Indian Agricultural Research Institute, New Delhi, during 1970-73 in case of irrigated rice indicate that treatment of urea with coaltar solution increased the grain yield from 35 quintals to 43 quintals per hectare and when treated with neem cake to 39 quintals per hectare.

(c) This will depend much upon the type of soil, amount of rains/irrigation received and turation of different rice varieties. In general, this treatment can bring about 10 per cent saving in Urea.
