Machinery in Maruti Car Factory, Gurgaon

2980. SHRI MADHU LIMAYS: Will the Minister of INDUSTRY AND CIVIL SUPPLIES be pleased to refer to the mutilated question on the installation of imported machinery in the Maruti Factory tabled by a Socialist Party M.P. during the Winter Session of Parliament and state:

(a) whether part of the machinery installed or in the process of installation in the Maruti Car Factory m Gurgaon District of Haryana has been fabricated in and imported from foreign countries;

(b) if so, the details of this imported machinery;

 (c) the total value of such imported machinery;

(d) whether any import licences were sought by the Maruti Limited and given by the Government for importing this machinery; and

(e) if so, whether use of imported machinery is consistent with the conditions attached to the Letter of Intent and/or industrial licence issued to Maruti Limited?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE OF INDUSTRY AND MINISTRY CIVIL SUPPLIES (SHRI Α. C. GEORGE): (a) to (c). Messrs. Maruti Limited did not seek any import licence for importing machinery nor were they given any such permission. Some of the machinery installed in Messrs. Maruti Ltd., have been purchased by the firm from within the country from the dealers in machine tools who are allowed to sell them on "stock and sale" basis.

(d) No, Sir.

(e) The industrial licence stipulated that no import of capital goods would be allowed. No imports have been asked for or given.

Setting up of Industries in Kerala
