No fresh foreign capital is being permitted in this industry.

Setting up of Industrial Units in Alwar

SHARMA): (a) to (c): Alwar district has been selected as an Industrially Backward District to qualify for (i) finance facilities concessional industries from all India term leading Financial Institutions; (2) Central Scheme of Investment Subsidy; (3) the Scheme of Income-tax Relief; (4) Preference for import of Raw Materials, Machinery and Components; and (5) Priority for supply of Machinery on Higher Purchase by the National Small Industry Corporation at concessional terms.
