THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI F. H. MOHSIN): (a) and (b). The Conference of Governors was held in New Delhi on 4th and 5th April, 1975. The Governors discussed the political and administrative situation in the States as well as the general economic situation in the country.

Savings in Plan and Nen-Plan Expenditure

8225. SHRI GAJADHAR MAJHI: Will the Minister of PLANNING be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Planning Commission has examined the plan and non-plan expenditure with a view to effect savings during the current year; and
- (b) if so, the findings thereof and the action taken by Government in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PLANNING (SHRI VIDYA CHARAN SHUKLA): (a) and (b). The Plan for the current year has been finalised only recently, keeping in view the need for stepping up outlay in crucial sectors of the economy and avoiding provision for inessential schemes. As such, the question of examining it with a view to effect savings does not arise at this stage.

As for non-plan expenditure, the Central and State Governments have already adopted a number of economy measures. The effect of these measures as well as the further economies considered feasible has been taken into account in assessing the resources for the Plan for the current year.
