Television Centre in Kerala

3324. SHRIMATI BHARGAVI THA-NKAPPAN: Will the Minister of IN-FORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Kerala State Government have made a representation for setting up of a television centre in Kerala; and
- (b) if so, Government's decision thereon?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI VIDYA CHARAN SHUKLA):
(a) Yes, Sir. In September 1975, the State Government had suggested extension of SITE programmes to Kerala and also the setting up of a studio and 3 Transmitting Stations during the Fifth Plan in the vicinity of Trivandrum, Cochin and Calicut.

(b) The feasibility of extending the SETS programmes to Kerala was examined. It was, however, found that it would not be possible to do so for technical reasons such as the strength of the signal, limited capacity of programme production facilities in edditional languages and other aspects of

the Instructional TV Experiment. As regards the second part of the State Government's suggestion, it was not found possible to set up any TV Centre during Fifth Plan in Kerala State due to constraints in resources.
