

Employment to Urdu Post-Graduates from J & K in A.I.E. and Television

3331. SHRI SYED AHMED AGA: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) whether Jammu and Kashmir Government had recommended to Central Government that post-graduates in Urdu from the State be considered for Central services, more particularly in Radio and Television;

(b) the action taken by Central Government in the matter; and

(c) the number of such persons already employed in Radio or Television?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS, DEPARTMENT OF PERSONNEL AND ADMINISTRATIVE REFORMS AND DEPARTMENT OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI OM MEHTA): (a) and (b). The Central Government have not received any such recommendation from the Jammu and Kashmir Government. However, Degrees/Diplomas awarded by Universities in India which are incorporated by an Act of the Central or State Legislature are recognised for the purpose of employment under the Central Government

(c) The number of post-graduates in Urdu from the State of J & K, working in Television in that State is two. Four staff artists who have passed M. A. (Urdu), are working in the radio stations in J & K State in various capacities.

Closure of Auto Ancillary Units

3332. SHRI B. S. BHAURA: Will the Minister of INDUSTRY AND CIVIL SUPPLIES be pleased to state:

(a) whether many of the auto ancillary units in the country have been closed down;

(b) if so, the reasons therefor;

(c) the total number of workers being retrenched as a result of these closures; and

(d) measures being taken to avert the crisis in this industry?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY AND CIVIL SUPPLIES (SHRI A. C. GEORGE):

(a) At present three automobile ancillary units in the organised sector are closed.

(b) One unit has been closed down due to low off-take of its products, second due to some management problems and third on account of State Government's directive to shift the unit from residential area to Industrial area.

(c) 294 workers have been affected as a result of these closures.

(d) There is no crisis in the industry as such.

राजस्थान में गांवों का विद्युतीकरण

3333. श्री लालजो भाई : क्या ऊर्जा मंत्री यह बनाने की कृपा करेंगे कि ग्रामीण विद्युतीकरण निगम के कार्यक्रम के अंतर्गत राजस्थान में कितने गांवों में विद्युतीकरण का कार्य चल रहा है और कितने गांवों में यह चालू किया जाने वाला है ?

ऊर्जा मंत्रालय में उत्सवो (प्रो० सिद्धेश्वर प्रसाद) : ग्राम विद्युतीकरण निगम लिमिटेड ने अब तक राजस्थान की 94 ग्राम विद्युतीकरण स्कीमें स्वीकृत की हैं। इन स्कीमों में 5186 नए गांवों के विद्युतीकरण की योजना है। इनमें से 31-12-1975 तक 1816 गांव विद्युतीकृत किए गए। शेष गांवों में विद्युतीकरण कार्य प्रगति पर है।

राजस्थान में और अखिक गांवों के विद्युतीकरण हेतु स्कीमों की स्वीकृति, राज्य बिजली बोर्ड द्वारा प्रायोजित की गई और निगम द्वारा अपने निश्चित मानदण्डों तथा मार्गदर्शी सिद्धांतों के अनुसार अनुमोदित की गई ग्राम विद्युतीकरण स्कीमों की संख्या पर निर्भर होगा ।

Reorganisation of Marketing operation of Coal India Limited

(a) whether there is a proposal to reorganise and rationalise the marketing operation of Coal India Ltd.; and

(b) if so, the facts thereof?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF ENERGY (SHRI SIDDHESHWAR PRASAD): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) With a view to giving a thrust to sales and marketing activities, Coal India Limited have decided to reorganise their sales organisation by dividing the entire country into five zones, each allotted to a subsidiary company, as per details given below:—
