Supply of Milk Powder to Manipur

1390. Shri Rishang Keishing: Will the Minister of Health be pleased to state:

- (a) the quantity of milk powder allotted to Manipur in 1961;
- (b) whether it is a fact that milk powder so allotted was lifted by the Apex Co-operative Societies Imphal and Churachandpur;
- (c) if so, the expenditure incurred by the societies in bringing the milk powder from Calcutta to Imphal; and
- (d) the way in which the milk has been disposed off?

The Minister of Health (Dr. Sushila Nayar): (a) A total quantity of 50 Metric tons of milk powder was allotted by the Ministry of Food and Agriculture to Manipur for public sale during 1961-62. Besides, a quantity of 21.076 tons of milk powder was donated by the Red Cross and UNICEF.

- (b) Out of this 50 tons allotted for public sale, 25 tons was lifted by the Manipur Apex Co-operative Marketing Society Ltd. Imphal and balance 25 tons by the Tribal Kalvan Primary Co-operative Marketing Society Ltd., Churachandpur.
- (c) The actual expenditure incurred by the Manipur Apex Marketing Cooperative Society Ltd., Imphal, and the Tribal Kalyan Primary Marketing Society Ltd., Churachandpur, in lifting the milk consignments of 25 metric tons each from Calcutta to Imphal was Rs. 7,029:52 and Rs. 6,867.75 respectively on account of transport charges at Calcutta, Railway Freights, Handling charges, Motor freights from Dimapur to Imphal and journey expenses of the Officers of the Societies deputed to Calcutta. These are exclusive of the price of milk which amounts to Rs. 37,492.00 for 25 metric
- (d) The Societies sell the powder to consumers and retailers on wholesale and retail basis at prices fixed by the Manipur Administration, viz., Rs. 50.00 per bag of 56 lbs. and Re. 1 per lb.

The milk powder donated by Red Cross and the UNICEF was distributed free through the Maternity and Child Welfare and Public Health Centres, allied Institutions, Schools, etc.
