- (b) if so, what amount would be spent in its construction and the shares of State and Centre; and
- (c) what time will be taken for its completion?

The Deputy Minister in the Ministry of Railways (Shri Shahnawaz Khan):
(a) to (c). The Ministry of Transport
(Roads Wing) have accepted the proposal to provide a combined roadcum-rail bridge across the river
Jamuna at Kalpi, on Jhansi-Kanpur
Section, when the present weak girders are replaced in the near future.

The Central Railway Administration have been asked to prepare the design of the girders and work out the total cost as well as the share of the Road Authorities. It is too early to indicate the target for completion. The work will be taken up during the Third Five Year Plan period.

Implementation of National Cooperative Farming Advisory Board's Recommendations

Shrimati Maimoona Sultan:

Will the Minister of Community Development, Panchayati Raj and Cooperation be pleased to state:

- (a) how far the National Cooperative Farming Advisory Board's recommendation for starting co-operative farms among marginal landholders and landless people on cultivable Government lands has been implemented in different States;
- (b) the kind of Central aid such farms may expect to have;
- (c) whether any attempt has been made to get a correct estimate of Government lands available for cooperative farming; and

(d) if so, whether a State-wise statement will be laid on the Table?

The Deputy Minister in the Ministry of Community Development, Pancayati Raj and Cooperation (Shri S. D. Misra): (a) Following the recommendations of the National Cooperative Farming Advisory Board, the State Governments have organised 241 cooperative collective farming societies on cultivable government lands. Of these 34 societies are in pilot project areas and 207 outside the pilot project areas.

- (b) A statement showing the assistance given by the Centre and the States to the cooperative farming societies under the third Plan is given in the statement laid on the Table. [See Appendix II, annexure No. 98]
- (c) and (d): A committee appointed by Government of India has made an estimate of government lands available in blocks of 250 acres or more which can be brought under cultivation after reclamation. The data available is given in Statement laid on the Table. [See Appendix II, annexure No. 99].

No separate estimate has been made regarding areas available for cooperative farming. It may, however, be mentioned that it is the policy of the Government to allot such lands to cooperative farming societies on a preferential basis.

Remodelling of Dornakal and Khammam Stations
