China Clay Mines in Singbhum

- 1848. Shri H. C. SOY: Will the Minister of Mines and Fuel be pleased to state:
- (a) whether it is a fact that China clay mines in Singbhum in Bihar have been inspected during the last two years;
- (b) if so, defects found and action taken thereon;
- (c) whether the local ryots on whose lands mining operations are proposed to be conducted have been resisting the mine owners; and
 - (d) if so, the reasons for the same?

The Deputy Minister in the Ministry of Mines and Fuel (Shri Hajarnavis): (a) Yes.

- (b) The mining conditions in two of the 9 mines inspected were found to be satisfactory. Defects found in the other 7 mines relate to lack of proper quarrying benches and the malpractice of dumping the waste material on unproved ground. The mine owners, where these defects were observed were advised suitably at the spot to improve the mining methods and thereby lower the cost of production.
- (c) Government have no such information.
 - (d) Does not arise.
