**STATEMENT**

Planning Commission have not received any proposal from the Punjab State Government regarding Rs. 2 crore pilot projects to give impetus to the cottage industries and to provide hundred percent employment. However, the Planning Commission have allotted two rural industries projects to the Punjab State as a part of the recently formulated scheme for intensive development of rural industries in

46 selected areas all over India. The State Government have proposed the location of these two projects at Malerkotla and Palampur. In addition to the funds available for these areas in the State Plan and the Central Plan under the programmes for development of different village and small industries for these two areas and the funds available from institutional agencies, a specific provision may be made to ensure intensive development of rural industries.
