- (b) The extent to which these mutants could help in augmenting agricultural production can be known only after all the critical tests are completed.
- (c) Apart from the breeding of improved varieties with radiations, atomic energy is used in insect sterilization, pest control and disinfestation of foodgrains and for the preservation of foodgrain, fruit, fish and other food stuffs.

- (a) whether it is a fact that direct recruitment to Defence Services is made through the annual examinations conducted by the Union Public Service Commission;
- (b) whether it is also a fact that out of at least eight thousand boys who were recommended by the Commission for appointment to the Defence Services as Cadet during the last 15 years, only 14/15 Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes boys were recommended for such appointment; and
- (c) if so, the reason for the low percentage in direct recruitment and appointments to Armed Forces of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes?

THE DEFENCE MINISTER (SHRI SWARAN SINGH): (a) Recruitment of Commissioned Officers to the Armed Forces is made through examinations conducted by the Union Public Service Commission followed by interviews held by Services Selection Boards in the case of some entries and through interviews

held by Services Selection Boards alone in the case of other entries.

- (b) No, Sir; but it is a fact that the proportion of Scheduled Castes Scheduled Tribes in the officer cadre of the Armed Forces is not large.
- (c) The reason is that the selection is made for the available vacancies strictly on the basis of the merit list as recommended by the Selection agencies subject to medical fitness and verification of character and antecedents

M.Ps. BATCHES TO MEET JAWANS

3769. SHRI NITIRAJ SINGH CHAU-DHARY: Will the Minister of DE-FENCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any steps are being taken to regularly send batches of Members of Parliament to meet Jawans in forward areas: and

MISHRA): (a) and (b). vernment have arranged for visits by MPs to forward areas whenever a request in this regard has been received either from MPs or from the Lok Sabha or Raiva Sabha Secretariat. Thus, since August 1967, 33 MPs have visited forward areas in three batches. Subject to operational considerations, the procedure will continue to be followed.

MISHRA): (a) By notification published on 12th May 1967, the term of office of the elected members due to expire by 30th June 1967 was extended upto 31st March 1968 or the date of notification of election of their successors in office in the official gazette, whichever is earlier.

- (b) No, Sir. According to the election programme for holding elections on 16th June 1967, the date for presentation of Nomination papers to the Returning Officer was 16th May 1967. The Notification cancelling the said election programme was issued on 11th May 1967 and published in the Gazette on the 12th May 1967.
- (c) To delimit the wards with a view to provide only for single wards.
- (d) Before 31st March 1968 when the extended term of office of the elected members in question is due to expire.
