3800. SHRI B. K. DASCHOW-DHURY: Will the Minister of INFOR-MATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to refer to the reply given to unstarred Question No. 2052 on the 27th November, 1967 and state:

## Parties to Entertain Troops in Forward Areas

(b) and (c). Nine mobile units consisting of instrumentalists, singers, dancers, actors and actresses are being raised departmentally by the Song and Drama Division by open recruitment. In addition, some professional troupes may be utilised by Government for enter-

- tainment of troops as and when necessary.
- (d) About Rs. 12 lakes a year out of the budget of the Song and Drama Division.
