- (a) whether it is a fact that in July, 1963 some persons were arrested as Chinese spies;
- (b) whether the arrested persons were kept in Teju Jail in NEFA;
- (c) whether it is also a fact that the arrested persons in Teju Jail have absconded carrying with them five rifles and some bullets; and
- (d) the action taken against the Officers on duty?

The Deputy Minister in the Ministry of External Affairs (Shri Dinesh Singh): (a) Five Mishmis from remote northern villages of Lohit Frontier Division, NEFA, were arrested in May, 1963, for crossing the frontier and re-entering it without valid-documents.

(b) They were escorted down to Teju and remanded into judicial custody, under CRP guard pending enquiries.

- (c) At 5.30 a.m. on 24th July, they asked for water and overpowered a sentry during heavy rain. They escaped with four rifles and 190 rounds of ammunition belonging to the CRP guard. Two of them with one rifle have been re-captured and a search for the others continues.
- (d) An inquiry has been ordered through the Commandant of the CRP. It is still in progress.

Contract system in Coal Mines
