

(Shri Sham Nath): (a) The main structural work on the transmitter building has been completed. Flooring, electrification, sanitary installations, approach road, etc. are expected to be completed by November, 1963 and water supply is likely to become available by March, 1964.

School for Refugee Students

(c) Does not arise. The entire expenditure on the scheme is being met by the Government of India.
