Conferment of Foreign Titles on Indians

1936. Dr. L. Mr. Singhvi: Will the Prime Minister be pleased to state:

(a) whether any title has to date been conferred on any Indian citizen by any foreign State with or without the consent of the President of the Indian Republic; and

(b) if so, the names of the recipients, the dates of conferment and the exact description of the titles?

The Prime Minister, Minister of External Affairs and Minister of Atomic Energy (Shri Jawaharlal Nehru): (a) and (b). The Government of India are not aware of any Indian citizen having accepted a foreign title since the inauguration of the Constitution. However, further inquiries are being made and if any such case comes to light, particulars will be placed on the Table of the House.

Indo-Pak Officers' Conference

Will the Prime Minister be pleased to state:

(a) whether an Indo-Pakistan Officers' Conference took place in the Lathitilla area on 30th July, 1963;

(b) if so, the specific issues discussed therein; and

(c) the result thereof?

The Prime Minister, Minister of External Affairs and Minister of Atomic Energy (Shri Jawaharlal Nehru): (a) Yes Sir, the Brigade Commanders of both the countries met at Putni bridge, Lathitilla on 30th July, 1963.

(b) and (c). Both sides agreed to abide by the decisions taken at a joint meeting on 23rd July, 1962 in respect of the area of patrolling by the personnel of either country; it being agreed that-(a) no Indian personnel would patrol Lathitilla, west of Putnicherra Nala, and (b) no Pakistani personnel would patrol east of the western boundary of the villages Lathitilla and Dumabari.

Radio Station at Jammu

Will the Minister of Information and Broadcasting be pleased to state:

(a) whether the radio transmitter at Jammu is only of one-Kilowatt

and it cannot be heard even locally; and

(b) if so, the steps Government propose to take in this regard?

The Deputy Minister in the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting (Shri Sham Nath): (a) Jammu Station of the All India Radio has got two transmitters, one 1 kw mediumwave and the other 1 kw shortwave. Both these transmitters are heard well locally in the Jammu city and its environs. During night time Jammu gets satisfactory service from the transmitters operating at Srinagar also.

(b) In view of the above, there are no plans at present to augment the power of the transmitters at Jammu.
