The actual amount utilised by the State Government till 31st March 1963 was Rs. 123 36 lakhs (Rs. 59 78 lakhs from the Allocations and Rs. 63.58 lakhs from the Ordinary Reserve).

Tube-Wells in Orissa

The total number of exploratory bores proposed to be drilled by the Exploratory Tubewells Organisation is 24. Out of these, four bores which were drilled during 1962-63 had to be abandoned due to poor discharge of water. Such of the exploratory bores as give adequate discharge of water are converted into production tubewells and handed over to the State Government for its use. The estimated cost of the entire work is Rs. 9.00 lakhs.

The 24 exploratory bores are being drilled in the Districts of Mayurbhanj, Balasore, Cuttack and Puri.
