Government have set up a Committee recently consisting of officials and non-officials to make a study of the working of the voluntary price control scheme and suggest improvements. The copy of the order appointing the Committee is laid on the Table of the House. [Placed in Library. See No. LT-1896/63]. The Chairman of the Committee has been authorised to coopt a few more members as may be necessary.
