

The Deputy Minister in the Ministry of Education (Shri Bhakt Darshan):

(a) to (c). In consideration of the keen interest taken by the late Prime Minister Jawahar Lal Nehru, in sports and games, the All India Council of Sports at its meeting held on 28th August, 1964 has decided to recommend to the Nehru Memorial Committee the setting up of a first class sports stadium and other amenities for sports to be named after him. The Council also requested the Nehru Memorial Committee to make available funds for that purpose. No details have yet been worked out.

विदेशों में शिक्षा पा रहे मैसूर के छात्र

1530. श्री वीरप्पा : क्या शिक्षा मंत्री यह बताने की कृपा करेंगे कि :

(क) सरकारी व्यय पर मैसूर राज्य के कितने विद्यार्थी विदेशों में पढ़ रहे हैं; और

(ख) उन में अनुसूचित जातियों तथा अनुसूचित आदिम जातियों के कितने विद्यार्थी हैं ?

शिक्षा मंत्री (श्री मु० क० चागला) :

(क) अनुसूचित जातियों, अनुसूचित कबीलों तथा अन्य पिछड़े वर्गों को विदेश छात्रवृत्ति योजना नामक इस मंत्रालय की योजना के अन्तर्गत मैसूर राज्य के दो विद्यार्थी विदेश में अध्ययन कर रहे हैं। अन्य मंत्रालयों और राज्य सरकारों आदि द्वारा संचालित योजना के अन्तर्गत विदेशों में अध्ययन करने वाले अन्य विद्यार्थियों के सम्बन्ध में मंत्रालय के पास कोई सूचना नहीं है।

(ख) ये दोनों विद्यार्थी पिछड़े वर्गों के हैं।

Teachers of Non-Government Colleges

1531. Shri M. G. Thengondar: Will the Minister of Education be pleased

to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the University Grants Commission is contemplating the revision of pay scales of teachers in non-Government colleges in the country; and

(b) if so, when it is likely to take effect?

The Minister of Education (Shri M. C. Chagla): (a) and (b). In 1962, a Committee was appointed by the University Grants Commission to examine the question of revision of salary-scales of college teachers. The Committee made certain recommendations which were accepted by the Commission, in principle, in September, 1963 and it was proposed to take up the implementation of the scales recommended by the Committee in the Fourth Plan. Subsequently the Commission at its meeting held on 2-9-1964, has decided that the general question of revision of pay-scales of both college teachers and university teachers be further examined by a Committee which has since been constituted.
