Expenditure on Republic Day Parade (1968)

1500. SHRI VIKRAM CHAND MAHAJAN: Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

(a) the total expenditure incurred on Republic Day parade held on the 26th January, 1968; and

(b) what was the total seating capacity in all the Blocks?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF DEFENCE (SHRI L. N. MISHRA): (a) Accounts for the Republic Day Parade 1968 have not been finalised. A statement showing the expenditure incurred by the Central Government will be laid on the Table of the House after the accounts have been finalised.

Expenditure on Beating Retreat (1968)

Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

(a) the total expenditure incurred on the 'Beating of the Retreat' held on the 29th January, 1968 and what was the total seating capacity; and

(b) whether any invitation cards were issued to the general public and if so, how many and on what principle?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF DEFENCE (SHRI L. N. MISHRA): (a) and (b). Certain items of expenditure are common both for the Republic Day Parade and the Beating Retreat ceremony. It may, therefore, be difficult to indicate separately the expenditure incurred on the Beating Retreat ceremony on the 29th January 1968. However, information to the extent possible is being collected and will be laid on the table of the House.

The seating capacity at the Beating Retreat ceremony on the 29th January 1968 was for 14592 persons. Of this, 1120 seats were in an enclosure for which invitation cards admit cards were not required. In addition, for enclosures to which entry was by invitation cards, invitations for about 2,200 seats were issued to persons who according to available information were not holding any official positions. Requests for issue of invitation cards to such persons were considered on merits and invitation cards were issued subject to the availability of seats. In suitable cases, where it was not possible to issue invitation cards for the Beating Retreat ceremony on the 29th January (main ceremony), invitations were issued for the special show of the ceremony held on 28th January 1968.
