THE MINISTER OF TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION (DR. KARAN SINGH: (a) to (c). There are no schemes for the development of Tourist Spots in Tripura in the Central Sector. However, during the Fourth Five Year Plan the State Government have proposed the development of the following tourist centres at an estimated cost of Rs. 10 lakhs :—

1. Construction of Tourist Bungalow at Rudrasagar Lake.
2. Transport facilities.
3. Boating and other recreational facilities at Rudrasagar Lake.
4. Tourist publicity literature.

5. Organisation and setting up of staff training.

These proposals are under consideration.
