However, during the Fourth Five Year Plan the State Government have proposed the development of the following tourist centres at an estimated cost of Rs. 10 lakhs :---

- Construction of Tourist Bungalow at Rudrasagar Lake.
- 2. Transport facilities.
- 3. Boating and other recreational facilities at Rudrasagar Lake.
- 4. Tourist publicity literature.

- 5. Organisation and setting up of staff training.
